


Francisco-Javier López-García, is a specialized teacher in Music education, Titular organist at Avila Cathedral, Associated Professor to the University of Salamanca and Full Professor of Musical language at the Salamanca Music Academy. Born in 1971, he starts his musical studies in this Academy, furthering his organ studies at the Royal Higher Academy of Music in Madrid with Anselmo Serna and Miguel del Barco.

He completes his studies with Antonio Bernaldo de Quirós, Lucía Riaño, Roberto Fresco, Edward Koiman, Enrico Vicardi and Montserrat Torrent.

He has performed at Cathedrals such as Astorga, Ciudad Rodrigo, Asisi, Rome, Oporto, Sztergom (Hungary), Trier (Germany) and in several cycles of organ music in the spanish region of Castille-Leon like Jóvenes en Concierto, El Organo el camino, or El Sonido vivo, cycles on the Ages of Man, "Music in the districts of Segovia", Alcoy Organ Festival, Durango Organ Festival, etc. He has also worked with choral groups such as Ágora, La Santa Gregorian Choir, and Spanish Radio and Television Soloists, with sopranos Azucena López, Blanca Gómez, Sara Matarranz, barytone Miguel Viñé and flute players Juan Manuel Colino and Carlos-José Martínez, and trumpet Oscar-Gonzalo Grande-Pombo with whom he has recorded historic music on the Organ of Barco de Avila.

Sr. López-García occasionally performs as organist at the Cathedral of La Almudena in Madrid.
